With an emphasis on riding time and hands on training, we strive to reach a balance between work and play. Campers will receive one riding lesson each day along with instruction in horse care and safety. In addition to developing riding skills, campers will have an opportunity to express their creativity with various art materials, explore nature and their surroundings, swim, and make new friends.

**Our camp is for girls and boys ages 7 to 12** of all abilities and riding skills. Camp is offered in one-week sessions. Twelve weekly campers are divided into two riding groups, each with one instructor and CIT. It has been suggested that two sessions are best for beginners. Private lessons for beginners may be available before camp begins. Please contact Tiffany for information, 610-644-1963.

**We also offer a summer counselor-in-training (CIT) program** for 13 to 17 year olds who have higher level (intermediate or advanced) riding skills, and an interest in helping young campers learn to ride. The day runs from 8:00 am - 2:00 pm

**Camp begins** with drop-off at 9:00 am and group activities. At 9:30 beginner campers begin lessons while intermediate campers gather for the day's activities based on a weekly theme, followed by an opportunity to swim in a 4' deep pool located on the farm. We break for lunch together and reverse the schedule in the afternoon. **Pick up is promptly at 2:00pm. Extended Care after 2:00pm can be arranged prior to the start of camp at the rate of \$25.00/hour.**

**Directions: From Rte. 202** take Paoli Pike away from West Chester, East Towards Paoli. Go 3 1/2 miles, (cross Rte 352) to Line Rd. Turn right onto Line Rd. and follow to stop sign. Continue to first right into driveway. **From Paoli:** Rte 30 into Paoli and go west onto Paoli Pike Go 3 1/2 miles, to Line Rd. Turn Left onto Line Rd. and follow to stop sign. Continue to first right into driveway.
